AN ORDINANCE VOTED BY THE SELECTMEN TOWN OF ALSTEAD, NEW HAMPSHIRE

RELATIVE TO: DOG WASTE

- A. Duty to dispose. It shall be unlawful for each person who owns, possesses or controls a dog to not remove and dispose of any feces left by his/her dog on any sidewalk, street, park or other public area, or any other property other than the dog owner's property. Disposal of such feces shall be in a manner consistent with all applicable laws.
- B. Duty to possess means of removal; disposal. It shall be unlawful for any person who owns, possesses or controls a dog, to appear with that dog on any sidewalk, street, park, or other public area or any other property other than the dog owner's property, without possessing a means to remove any feces left by such dog.
- C. Enforcement; fines for violation. This section shall be enforced by the Alstead Police Department. Violation of this regulation shall be punished by a fine of **\$25.00** for each occurrence.
- D. Exception: This section shall not apply to any dog accompanying a person mentally or physically impaired and who because of such impairment is unable to comply with the requirements of this section.
