- VIII. James Booth works for <u>PC Connection</u>. He was involved in the design of the wifi system for Long Beach CA., Tuscon AZ., & is currently working on the wifi system for Miami FL. He discussed several other options for town-wide broadband. Many cities are starting to look at CBRS (Citizen's Broadband Radio Service). There is a lot of new technology coming. The current wifi protocol is Wifi6. Soon the protocol will be Wifi7.

Unfortunately, wifi is very expensive. 100 gigabit ethernet is coming soon. Private LTE is a scaled-down private & miniaturized version of the large-scale networks that most people are familiar with through their mobile phones. Lots of discussion of the options but no details about costs or who would pay.
