

The Alstead board of selectmen met in open session on Tuesday October 16, 2018 at 6:00 pm. Chairman Noonan called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm. Members present were Tim Noonan, Alan Dustin and Rock Wilson. Tim Noonan moved to go in to nonpublic RSA 91-A:3 at 6:01 pm, Rock Wilson seconded, roll call to enter into nonpublic was done, Tim Noonan-yes, Rock Wilson-yes and Alan Dustin-yes. Alan Dustin moved to exit nonpublic and reconvene public session at 6:25 pm, Rock Wilson seconded, roll call to seal the minutes Tim-no, Rock-no and Alan-no. 6:27 Tim led the pledge of allegiance.

Police Chief Steve Murrell presented department budget. Rock asked why he was requesting part time police officer. Steve said he would like increased coverage without involving the state police. Resident Glenn Elsesser asked what they would drive for a cruiser, Steve said they would drive either Adam's or Steve's. Discussion took place on including any overtime into the budget regardless of whether it is for the grant so it doesn't appear over budget. Tim said they will take his budget into consideration and will work on it.

Ambulance Chief Jesse Moore presented department budget which was not much change from last year. Very little discussion took place.

Charlotte presented Exec., General Govt., Personnel Amin., and Welfare budget. Some discussion took place on replacement of file server. Discussed to put in general government new equipment line. Tim thought Welfare numbers were low and requested to increase some. Charlotte indicated that she was still waiting for numbers from health agencies and assessors so these figures were an estimate.

Discussion took place on getting water at the town barn. Rock will call someone to see if they can come out and look at it to see what is needed.

Tim asked if any performance review had been done. Charlotte said she hadn't received any. Tim asked Charlotte to reach out to the department heads on this.

Selectmen asked Charlotte to reach out to DES to inquire on an update on the status of the Clark demolition.

Selectmen all agreed to inform Prescott to drain Vilas Pool.

Discussion took place on whether AFLAC employee paid benefits should be offered to both part time and full-time employees. Rock motioned for it to be offered to full time employees only, Alan seconded, motion passed unanimously.

Tim mentioned that Colleen Fisk got all of her personal belongings that she wanted from the property on Sunday, October 14th. She had said to Tim that Albert would be over to remove the vehicles.

Rock mentioned that the backhoe at the transfer station will not be able to push snow in its current condition. Rock said he could repair it for \$15,000 but town needs to get more quotes. Wants Prescott to call to get quotes from others and will let Prescott know.

Alan moved to accept the minutes as amended, Rock seconded, motion passed unanimously.

Alan moved to adjourn, Rock seconded meeting adjourned at 7:50 pm.
