CALL TO ORDER: Chairman Alan Dustin called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE: At 6:00 p.m. Alan led the Pledge of Allegiance.

DISCUSSION: The Langdon Selectmen attended the meeting in response to the letter they received about the cost increase for the transfer station beginning in 2020. Jodi explained that the cost to recycle plastic is significantly more than not recycling and that it was agreed upon not to recycle for now. There are other cost increases as well and Jodi gave Devin and Lou a breakdown of this. After some discussion, Devin and Lou agreed the increase is fair.

Mary Ann reviewed the Fire Dept. budget with Kim. After some discussion and questions on the amounts, there were no changes made at this time.

Some discussion took place on the unanticipated revenue and whether or not to purchase new chairs for the conference room with any money left over after the other requests. No decision was made.
