

The Alstead select board met in open session on Tuesday April 26, 2016 at the municipal offices. Chris Rietmann called the meeting to order at 6:30. Tim Noonan led the group in the pledge of allegiance. The selectmen signed the payment and payroll manifests.

Chris made a motion to accept the amended minutes, Rock seconded and motion was passed.

Jeff Marsden presented the revised Warren Brook Project contract to be signed. He explained he had made changes to the payment portion of the contract and not to exceed the agreed amount. Tim Noonan asked who the private donor is and what happens if they do not pay. There was no one listed on the contract. The other selectmen asked Kelly to look in to this before they would agree to sign.

All three selectmen has agreed for Kelly to add an IPAD onto the U.S cellular plan to accept credit payments at the transfer station. Kelly will work with Jodi setting this up. Tim reported there is a company looking at recycling clothing. They set up a bin for people to drop off their clothing and they pay the town 2 cents per pound.

Chris is recommending a committee be set up to look into the transfer station operations. He is working on outlining guidelines. He would like 6 people on this committee. He is feels members of the AABC, DPW, transfer station and select board should be involved. More information will be coming in the next several weeks.

The Bragg Lane property was discussed briefly and Chris feels a similar committee needs to be formed. The planning board feels they are responsible for overseeing this. Further information will be available in the following weeks.

Department Head Chief Marcello D'Alessandro reported as of January 1st to April 26, 2016 the police department has responded to 57 motor vehicle stops, 44 warnings, 13 citations, 8 incidents reports, and 7 arrests. Officer Howard is currently doing some cross training in Walpole and once he is fully trained the police department will have two shifts. Officer Landry was promoted to Sargent. Marcello has done employee reviews. This month the staff will be attending field training, DWI and Leadership training and opioid training. Marcello and Roger are certified in Narcan training. The police have several upcoming events they are participating in. The first is the old prescription drop off in Alstead, CAT shock training, and Vilas Career day. Marcello is looking into drug prevention programs. He will work with the principals of the schools on multiple avenues to help educate our youth.

In the future the police department would be looking into replace the old cruiser and the radio tower. The radio tower on Cobb hill needs a better reception and a better solution for the wires. The wires are just on the ground. A new tower will need to be located.

The vehicle maintenance records was discussed briefly by the group. Kelly will ask David Crosby to bring his maintenance records at next week's meeting.

Bobbie asked about having the small field behind Vilas Pool that needs to be brush hogged.

Tim Noonan went over the winter policy. Kelly gave the selectmen David Crosby's changes and all three selectmen agreed to accept his changes. Chris made a motion to accept the winter policy as amended, Tim Noonan seconded, and motion was passed 3-3.

Kelly gave the selectmen the RFP for the fire station door for them to review. The selectmen decided on a date to close the bids. Chris made a motion to accept the RFP with the new dates, Rock Wilson seconded and motion passed 3-3.

Griffin Hill logging was discussed. It doesn't look terrible but the BOS will monitor how it is left after the loggers are done. Someone from the snowmobile club may want to look at this as also.

The BOS discussed briefly about getting more information on the intent to cut forms and what roads will be used. David is responsible for taking before and after pictures.

Glenn Elsesser reported holes were dug at MT Vilas. Randy Rhoades will give the BOS a report to determine what value it is to the town.

Ambulance reimbursements were discussed. Kelly explained she had talked to EMS billing and for the year of 2015 \$20,058.55 was billed out.

Chris made a motion to adjourn, Tim seconded motion passed 3-3, meeting adjourned at 8:54.
Chris made a motion to go into executive session RSA A: 3 (a) at 8:58.
