MEETING MINUTES October 10, 2016

PB Members present: Peter Rhoades/Chairman, David Konesko, Joyce Curll, and Matt Saxton/Alternate to the ex officio. Chris Hanson/Budget Committee was also present.

Rhoades/Chairman opened the Meeting at 7:00PM. At 7:15pm, the Bragg Lane Public Hearing was opened. It was noted that on 10/26/16 the Planning Board will be meeting with the Budget Committee at 6:30pm to discuss the CIP Plan.

Different uses for Bragg Lane were discussed:

community garden space	emergency services building
Food Shelf/Friendly Meal	town hall
athletic fields	municipal swimming pool
potential access to Vilas Pool	skate park
elderly housing	housing development
public use	workforce housing
public parking	build a pavilion
town wide yardsale	farmers market

Saxton stated that when the property was purchased it was all about long range planning. Hanson stated that the Budget Committee has spoken about the property – what it is going to be/what is it good to use for/are we losing tax dollars/revenue by keeping it, etc. Rhoades stated when the purchase was made, the Bragg Lane property was the only downtown land available in the foreseeable future (adding that the only other property that may become available is the Blanchflower Lumber site).

Saxton asked if the Budget Committee could find money to have the property cleaned up/flattened out – making the property walkable, moveable, useful, flat and green. It was noted that soccer fields would not cost a lot; that a farmer could harvest it for hay; that Community Fitness Grants may be available. Hanson stated that *the Budget Committee would like to see a Warrant Article on this, but *an estimate of cost would be needed – Saxton stated that a goal would be to *do this initial process in 2017. *Potential people (Lonn Livengood or Jeff Marsden) were discussed to give an estimate. Curll stated it is important to reach out to interested parties in town (such as the Orchard School, the Budget Committee, etc).

A Motion (Saxton/Curll) was made to adjourn the Meeting. The Motion passed. Meeting adjourned at 8:35PM.
