I, Minutes from October - Accepted as corrected.

II, Lon Livengood, Earthworks L.L.C. - Lon presented his plan for installing a culvert in a driveway entrance to a property off Rogers Road. The area is designated as a wetland. Therefore, he hired a certified soil scientist to map the area. Since it has a small impact, he seeks a "Permit By Notification" from NH DES that will shorten the time from 30 days to 10 days. The ACC signed and approved the form for him to submit. Sarah and Joyce CC will do a site walk with him next week. Lon also notified abutters to the property and checked for endangered species.

III, Warren Brook Restoration Project update - It is complete! The ACC will send a letter of thanks to cooperating groups, such as DES and schools. We will write a report for the Town of Alstead regarding the educational and environmental benefits of this project. NH Fish and Game will do fish monitoring; already found are river chub and dace.

IV, Warrant Article for Town Forest update - Sarah and other ACC members presented the draft warrant article for a Forest Management Fund to the Selectboard to go on ballot for March 2017. The Selectboard will consider it. We discussed options for getting this warrant article on the ballot.

V, Letter of thanks to area schools for participation in Warren Brook Restoration plantings - We'll send a letter to six schools whose 6-7-8th grade children helped plant 1,200 silky dogwoods and willows.

VI, Easement Monitoring - Sarah and Joyce CC will walk the Burroughs and Fox properties.

VII, ACC Budget submitted to Town Office.
