CALL TO ORDER: Alan Dustin called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE: At 6:00 p.m. Alan Dustin led the Pledge of Allegiance.

ACTION ITEMS: Bill and payroll manifests signed; Intent to Cut signed; Vilas Pool bill signed.

DISCUSSION: Jodi addressed the board about putting gates up around the dumpsters so no one falls in. ***The Board agreed unanimously to have this done.***

Jodi mentioned that there are a few trees that need to be cut in the cemeteries. Maple Side, Wards and North Cemetery. She said that she will be sending letters to the property owners that are near the trees to let them know.

Brief discussion took place regarding the truck and trailer parked across the street from the library with a for sale sign. Mary Ann wanted to know if there was something that could be done to notify the owner not to park it there indefinitely. Alan and Rock said to contact Police Chief Stephen Murrell to see if anything can be done.

Mary Ann reviewed with the Board about the Articles of Agreement committee she is on and asked if they had any feedback that she could present at the next meeting.

Alan mentioned that the Fire Dept. tanker was used in Langdon to fill a swimming pool. Brief discussion took place on whether equipment should be taken out of town and whether it is a liability filling pools. Asked Charlotte to invite Kim to the next meeting.

Rock brought up the sign on Camp Brook Rd that it has "no thru trucks". He said to notify Prescott to take this down. It has no weight limit on it so the meaning would include all trucks.

Charlotte asked about providing the town permit number for Mill Hollow to send out a mailing. She informed the Board that Mill Hollow will be providing all the materials, pay the postage and provide the volunteers to put the mailing together. After a brief discussion, on a motion by Rock Wilson, seconded by Alan Dustin, ***2/3 of the Board voted to not provide the town permit number to Mill Hollow.***

MINUTES FROM PREVIOUS MEETING: Minutes of July 2, 2019: On a motion by Mary Ann Wolf, seconded by Rock Wilson; ***the Board voted to approve the minutes.***

PUBLIC COMMENTS: Bil Staats presented more information to the board on the water that sits on March Hill. After a brief discussion Rock and Alan agreed and Alan will speak with Prescott about this.

On a motion by Rock, seconded by Mary Ann ***the Board voted unanimously to adjourn at 7:25 p.m.***
