CALL TO ORDER: Rock Wilson called the Public Hearing regarding the winter ordinances to order at 6:03 p.m. Rock led in the Pledge of Allegiance.

OPEN FORUM: Charlotte read the ordinances. After some discussion the ordinances were signed. Public hearing adjourned at 6:20.

NEW BUSINESS: Signed payroll and bill manifest, intent to cuts, Vilas Pool bill.

The Board acknowledged Sarah Webb. Sarah spoke on the issue of improving the view at Pratt Rock. The plan is to clear about a half an acre of small trees that are 1-4 inch in diameter at the base. Peter Renzleman will do the cutting. The Kroka crew of about 3 will limb and process what has been cut. The timeframe is Jan. 28-30 and Feb. 2-5. The cut will not involve any trees below the trail. The Board thought this was great and were all in agreement.

Some discussion took place on an email regarding an employee at the library with COVID and how to handle it. Joe said he felt we should contact the library trustees and have them put it on their library website. Joe will contact Matt Saxton.

Prescott presented a purchase order for two new tires for the tractor. Just under 2k. Most tires are government issued so they get a discount. He pointed out that he will continue with purchase orders over \$1,000 however the policy does state that highway's limit is \$5,000 before needing a purchase order.
