

The Alstead board of selectmen met in open session on Tuesday October 11, 2016 at 6:30 at the municipal offices. Chairman Chris Rietmann and Tim Noonan were present. Chairman Chris Rietmann called the meeting to order at 6:40. Tim led the pledge of allegiance. Tim Noonan moved to accept the minutes as written, Chris Rietmann seconded.

Rich Nalevanko reported there are clogged drains on Hill Rd and has asked several times before. Kelly will ask David to look at these and report back to the BOS.

Chris Hansen reported there is a light that isn't working at the Prospect and Center St. Kelly will call and report it to the electric company tomorrow.

Two resident teens came back and asked if the select board had heard back from the insurance company about building a BMX track. Chris Rietmann reviewed with the boys what the insurance company requires. They first need to have an adult overseeing their project and once they can find an adult we can provide the adult the remaining requirements to complete the job.

The selectmen signed the 3 year contract with NRRRA.

Glenn asked about the Langdon compactor equipment, who was pouring the pad, when are we picking it up and how much time away from other DPW jobs will it take. The selectmen felt these were questions David could answer these at the meeting on November 1, 2016.

The transfer station overdue bills were discussed about the best way to collect unpaid bills. Chris has finished designing the vouchers for cash payments, he just needs to have them printed up. The selectmen feel they shouldn't deny anyone the right to use the transfer station just because they haven't paid their bill.

Tim reviewed Carol Reller's 3% tax cap chart and would like to the BOS to decide on a formula to use and a working number for the budget. Tim made a motion to use \$1,639,464.17 as their working number, Chris seconded and motion passed. There was a lot of discussion about an easier formula to use, and if someone challenged their formula are the selectmen able to justify their position. The AABC offered their assistance explaining how they came up with the chart.

The budget was reviewed line by line, with minor concerns about a few line items that Kelly will look into.

Tim Noonan made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 8:34 and Chris Rietmann seconded.
