

The Alstead board of selectmen met in open session on February 16, 2016 at 6:30 at the municipal offices. Joel McCarty and Chris Reitmann were present along with 7 residents.

Joel announced the meeting will be broadcasted by Mike Gordon.
Minutes were read and accepted with spelling corrections.

Linda reported the Town report is almost complete but she may need help with formatting it. Chris offered to help.

The AABC has requested to include communication about the unassigned fund balance in their mailing. Joel will draft a letter for the public mailing. The selectmen would like to review the AABC's wording before the mailing goes out.

The EMSG is meeting with vendors and negotiating the specifics. The committee would like to send out a town mailing explaining their findings. After some discussion the selectmen unanimously voted to have mailing of this kind come out of the department discretionary funds.

Joel reported the Cold River Advisory Committee met with the conservation committee and they have agreed to support this project and give them the money to reach their goal fund.

We still have not heard back from the NH Securities about the towns trust funds. Kelly will follow up with a letter to them.

Glen asked about selling town land. He will contact Dennis Molesky on the planning board and discuss this with him.

Glenn would like to order professional looking signs. He will check with Vista Print and Staples for the best price.

Jesse reported he received a letter from Zoll stating they would no longer be able to service or get parts for the Alstead's defibrillator because of its age. Jesse said the cost of a new one is \$30,000. Jesse will write up a request and Joel will put in the statewide website for bids on defibrillators. We may need to look at adding a new fund for equipment or add to an existing fund.

The selectmen unanimously agreed to go into nonpublic per RSA (91-A:3(AC)).
