

Product Sales on Bragg Lane Policy Town of Alstead

1. Background

The Town of Alstead's allows residents to use the timber frame pavilion on Bragg Lane to sell local products.

2. Purpose

This policy is designed to provide a uniform Town policy for resident usage of the Town's pavilion located on Bragg Lane.

3. Process


- a. Prior approval by the Select Board, or their designee, is necessary before using the pavilion to sell products.
- b. The Select Board or their designee, reserves the right to deny an item or product.
- c. The use of Bragg Lane pavilion for the sale of merchandise is limited to local vendors, who are growers, craft persons, and/or producers of homemade products.
- d. Yard sales on the pavilion are prohibited, as residents may rent space during the Vilas Middle School PTO Community Day on Millot Green. This is a yearly event.
- e. Only products grown or produced within the local area may be sold on the Brage Lane property. Examples of saleable items are:

- Fruits and vegetables – grown by the vendor
- Meat products – 100% from animals raised by the vendor
- Honey and bee products – produced and bottled/packaged by the vendor
- Milk and other dairy products – produced by the vendor's own herd
- Eggs – from the vendor's own fowl
- Maple Products – processed by the vendor from the vendor's own or rented sugarbush
- Baked goods – fresh baked and prepared from scratch by the vendor
- Field and greenhouse grown plants, flowers, cut flowers, and herbs – grown by the vendor
- Crafts – high quality craft items designed and produced by the vendor

4. Exceptions

Exceptions to the policy will be determined on a case-by-case basis by the Select Board.
