## Alcohol Policy Town of Alstead

- 1. Alcoholic beverages are allowed in the Town Hall/Alstead Center Fire Station building and Vilas Pool facility for PRIVATE FUNCTIONS ONLY by approved application to the Select Board. Renter is completely responsible for ALL conduct and activity inside the facility.
- 2. Alcoholic beverages are permitted on a "bring your own" basis. The renter MUST provide a certificate of Tenant Users liability Insurance Protection (TULIP) in the amount of \$1,000,000 each occurrence, with the "Town of Alstead" named as additionally insured, 15 days prior to the event. Any organization, charitable or otherwise, holding a one-day function will require application to the NH Liquor Commission. If a private caterer is hired, a liquor license issued by the State of New Hampshire Liquor Commission will be required 15 days in advance of the event, together with a Certificate of Liability and Waiver. - 3. All trash is the responsibility of the renter and must be removed from the property at the conclusion of the event unless otherwise arranged.
- 4. All housekeeping is the responsibility of the renter unless otherwise arranged, all buildings and their associated property will be expected to be returned, put away and otherwise treated with care and respect. Any and all damage will be the responsibility of the renter.
- 5. Any person desiring to conduct an event with alcohol at the Town Hall/Alstead Center Fire Station building and Vilas Pool facility shall make application for police attendance at that function. The hiring of police detail officer(s) may be required for the event. The Chief of Police, or his or her designee, depending on the type of activity and number of persons in attendance, will determine whether a detail is necessary and if so, the number of officers required. It is the responsibility of the renter to arrange and pay for police presence for the duration of the event. This must be arranged with the Alstead Police Department 30 days in advance.
