The Board reviewed the Revenue and Expense report for 2019 that Charlotte presented. The Board liked this report, said they had never seen it before. Tim told Charlotte that it was good to have this report or at least bring to the Boards attention anything that looks like there may be a problem.

Joe Levesque addressed the Board to say he wanted to mention to Charlotte that the time of the deliberative session was not on the website. Charlotte will add this.

Discussion to place on the changes brought up that Mitchie emailed Charlotte regarding the Drewsville bridge. The Board wanted to wait and discuss this further after March.

Glenn Elsesser addressed the Board on the other two bridges that need to be done. Tim mentioned that Prescott is looking into the cost of invert paving for these. Glenn asked whether they had looked into getting a contract for roadside mowing. After some discussion, no decision was made. Glenn asked whether they received the email on the upcoming culvert class being held in Acworth in April. The Board said they had.

Discussion to place on Vilas Pool. Glenn wanted to know who was in charge this year. The Board has not decided yet. Various topics took place, one being the cost of the internet access throughout the year and if it was necessary. The Board all agreed that this should be disconnected.
