

## ORDINANCE

### ALSTEAD, NEW HAMPSHIRE

#### AN ORDINANCE FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A STREET NUMBERING SYSTEM

##### Section 1. PURPOSE

- A. To establish a uniform system of numbering properties in the Town of Alstead.
- B. To promote efficiency in locating properties within the Town.
- C. To identify roads and road problems within the community.
- D. To provide expedient emergency response by fire, police, rescue and other emergency services.

##### Section 2. PARTIES AFFECTED

Numbers will be assigned to all buildings and lots which have applied for driveway permits within the Town of Alstead. Further numbers will be assigned by the Town Offices when owners apply for driveway permits.

##### Section 3. PROCEDURES

All owners of buildings or lots within the limits of the Town of Alstead shall affix designated numbers (original numbers provided) to the building if they are visible from the road. If the numbers are not visible from the road, the numbers are to be affixed to the mailbox or on sign posts on the road in front of the buildings or lots. The numbers shall be 3" high by 2 1/2" wide reflectorized numbers.

##### Section 4. PENALTY

Whoever shall fail to comply with any provision of this ordinance within one year of enactment shall be guilty of a Violation with penalty not to exceed \$100.00.

##### Section 5. EFFECTIVE DATE


This ordinance shall take effect December 15<sup>th</sup>, 2000 in every locality within the Town except the Walpole Valley Road which shall take effect on January 30<sup>th</sup>, 2001.


Section 6. AMENDMENTS

This ordinance may be amended as provided under any and all applicable chapters of the Revised Statutes Annotated of New Hampshire.
