II, Prime Wetlands selection process with Jeff Littleton, Moosewood Ecological

- Jeff provided a selection method for wetlands using a single function, such as Largest 10%. He suggested we identify those, and then repeat the selection with another function, thereby, identifying which wetlands to focus on for Prime designation process.
- He will meet with us again in May.
