The Alstead board of selectmen met in open session on Tuesday August 1, 2017 at 6:30 at the municipal offices. Members present were Chairman Rock Wilson, Tim Noonan and Alan Dustin. Chairman Wilson called the meeting to order at 6:35. Tim led the pledge of allegiance. Alan moved to accept the amended minutes, Rock Wilson seconded, motion passed.

The board discussed with Mary Lou and other Friendly meals volunteers what equipment would be necessary to move back into the Town Hall. Alan reported the CIP committee would like to see some cabinets built for the Town Hall for supplies. After much discussion, it was decided the large stainless cabinet would need castor wheels put on it if it was necessary to go back into the Town Hall. Mary Lou will look into finding these, David offer to help also. The board asked about how many keys have been given out to other Friendly Meals volunteers. Mary Lou answered only 4 keys. The board reiterated no one shall be in the Town Hall late at night or staying at the Town Hall overnight.

David reported the grading had been started and chloride will be done depending upon the rain. He went on to report the stumps on South Woods have been removed. He is starting to look into the prices for a broom for the upcoming budget season. Glenn asked about selling the old truck on municibid. NO decision was made to sell the old truck.

The board will plan on a public hearing to accept the unanticipated funds from the highway block grant. The public hearing is set for Tuesday August 15, 2017 at 6:30 at the Town Hall.

Jane Quaglin spoke on behalf of Bob Quaglin, he plans to meet with David next week and go over the job descriptions.

The board reviewed and signed the no overnight parking ordinance Chief Murrell had prepared.

Rock Wilson moved to adjourn, Alan Dustin seconded, meeting adjourned at 8:35.
