

The Alstead board of selectmen met in open session on Tuesday August 22, 2017 at 6:30 at the town offices. Members that were present were Rock Wilson, Tim Noonan and Alan Dustin. Tim led the pledge of allegiance. Alan Dustin moved to accept the minutes as read, Rock Wilson seconded it, motion passed.

Police Chief Steve Murrell reported he and Sargent Howard have completed several specialized training courses and they are currently working on completing the NARCAN training to carry and administer. The department has also been taking online classes. Steve reported that having a police officer patrol during the even hours has helped reduce illegal activity. This Saturday 8/26/17 he will be at the transfer station from 10:00 -12:00 for a meet and greet. He has called JA Allen to find out if the security camera quote is still valid. He will meet with Mike Kercewich about getting the no parking and no authorized parking signs ordered. He still doesn't have the radar speed device back from Langdon. It still needs the tire and battery repaired. The board and Steve reviewed the budget and overall it looks good. Steve reported the new equipment line will be over.

Several library trustees reported to the board about installing temporary steps at the library. There are several different options either put out a RFP for the temporary steps or if the trustees have some qualified volunteers in mind to install them. The trustees estimate the cost of materials would be \$2,500.00 +/- . After much discussion, the board agreed to have volunteers do the work but would like to see the material cost. Mike Jasmine will get more information from Rock.

Kelly Wright reported about the Town Hall painting. She met with the contractor and he plans to come in and do the touch up on the floor. The town hall won't be available for Friendly Meals or other functions for 2-3 weeks after the work is done. Kelly has already informed all parties who this will affect.

The board reported the chloride is being spread. They reviewed the gravel bid from Fuzzy Brother's. After discussion, the board decided to have a meeting with Mike Kercewich to review the gravel amounts. The meeting is a public meeting at 6:00 am on 8/24/17 at the highway barn. There was some discussion about the highway budget and the board agreed to review this with Mike in September.

Glenn reported he plans to start discussing the CIP with the departments.

Alan Dustin moved to adjourn, Rock Wilson seconded meeting adjourned at 7:40.
